TMIP-J Delivers Service Pack 4 to Military Infrastructure Offices

The Theater Medical Information Program – Joint (TMIP-J) delivered to the Military Departments Service Pack (SP) 4 of Block 1 on Friday, Dec. 8. SP4 provides sites using the Composite Health Care System New Technology (CHCS-NT) application an automated process for updating the Defense Medical Information System (DMIS) identification codes.

The CHCS-NT application is used in deployed settings to capture inpatient care data and manage medical services in the areas of pharmacy, laboratory and x-ray reports. Prior to the delivery of SP4, sites using CHCS-NT used a manual, time-intensive process to update DMIS identification codes. This new automated process alleviates the burden of manually updating information and significantly decreases the potential for human error.

SP4 is the fourth in a series of service packs designed to provide TMIP-J software suite users with necessary upgrades and enhancements.

About TMIP

The Theater Medical Information Program is an integrated suite of software that supports complete clinical care documentation, medical supply and equipment tracking, patient movement visibility, and health surveillance in an austere communications environment. As part of the Military Health System, the Theater Medical Information Program provides medical information management technology to support the medical business practice in a deployed environment. It also serves as the medical component for both the Global Combat Support System and the Global Command and Control System.
